The Chairman reported upon the lack of suitable play equipment for 5-9 year olds at the play area off Donnington Drive which meant families had to walk a long way to a play area which was suitable.

Test Valley Borough Council (TVBC) did not have sufficient finances to enhance the play area. However, the Chairman suggested that the Parish Council provide a sum of £5,000 to enhance the play area provided that TVBC could match this sum. Any enhancements would be dependent upon the outcome of a public consultation exercise which would be undertaken by TVBC.

Resolved:

That a sum of £5,000, funded from savings within the current budget, be provided for enhancements to the play area mentioned above, provided that this sum is matched by Test Valley Borough Council, that the outcome of the public consultation exercise is favourable and that the equipment is suitable for 5-9 year old children.
