**2 Matters Arising**

The majority were around the Whitenap development. Some 900 comments were in relation to the hoe Lane development in North Baddesly. Mrs Tilling also reported that TVBC was to hold a Sparkle day on 15 May in the Wicklow Drive area. In essence this was a general clean up of the area.

Councillor Dowden in his capacity as County Councillor referred to a complaint regarding storage skips in Castle lane which were being used to store the old lighting columns. This had now been resolved.
