## 82 Community Governance Review discussion

Councillors discussed the matters arising from the new warding arrangements. Councillors agreed that Valley Park should review the situation and request a mini Community Governance Review to be carried out in 2022, meaning that any de-warding could come into effect for the next scheduled elections in 2023.

#### Resolved:

That a record be kept and a further review to take place closer to 2022.

## 83 Borough and County member reports

It was reported that lorries damaged street signs in Valley Park. Cllr Dowden mentioned that he had previously requested a lorry ban on Knightwood Road, which is classified by the County as a distributor road, which have not been considered yet by the County Council.

Cllr Dowden reported that grass verge at the top of Knightwood Road/Flexford Road was caused by an Open Reach vehicle, which got stuck and needed to be removed. Test Valley Borough Council repaired this.

Cllr Dowden informed the Council that the Valley Park Community Association, with the support from the Parish Council, received a £15k grant from the County Council towards refurbishment of the Community Centre.

Cllr Dowden informed that Sgt White has been seconded to carry out some work outside of the region for a few months and was temporary replaced by Sgt Russell Taylor. The Clerk was asked to provide the new email address to the councillors.

Councillors were pleased to hear that Valley Park Parish Council tax is going to be the lowest in the Borough of Test Valley. A comparison with the other parish rates for band D was shown:
