Youth Provision And Volunteers In Valley Park

Hampshire County Council Accredited Community Safety officer Clive Fortune is pioneering a scheme to provide youth provision for children in the Valley Park area of Test Valley. A room has been donated by Chris Hughes of the Knightwood Leisure Centre which will provide a base to give local children something to do on a Friday night.

Clive Fortune said: "I have been patrolling the area now for just over a year and one thing I have noticed is the number of teenagers on the streets on a Friday night causing us problems within the community. The majority of the children are fine and well behaved, but one thing they are very conscious of is that there is limited provision for them in the area and they get bored and disruptive. I am looking for volunteers willing to give up a few hours on a Friday night to take this project forward and give children within Valley Park a central meeting point and sense of belonging within their community."

HCC, Cllr Alan Dowden said: "The County Council and the Valley Park Parish Council are committed to increasing opportunities for young people and helping them lead safe, positive lives. They help foster a real community spirit in a healthy and relaxed environment.
