51 Borough and County member reports

Cllr Dowden informed that both Borough and County authorities are in discussion to resolve the flooding concerns on School Lane. The pipework replacement is included in the Operation Resilience Programme and work will be carried out early next year.

Councillors received complaints from residents that pupils who attend Toynbee School and use the cycle paths in Valley Park (predominantly the path connecting the St Francis School and the train station) are riding very fast. It was agreed that the Parish Clerk writes a letter to the HT at Toynbee to notify pupils who live in Valley Park to ride responsibly on the cycle path.

The Parish Council's Bid for CIL money to plant mature trees was, sadly, not successful in this round. The two successful bids were for a Cycle Route in Stockbridge and St John's House in Romsey.
